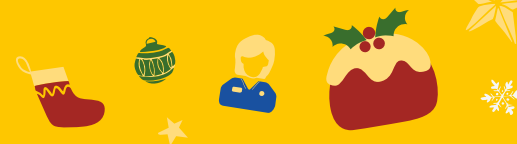




Have a very merry Quizmas!

Your guide to hosting a successful Christmas quiz fundraiser



Thank you for hosting a Christmas quiz. We've got everything you need to make it an absolute cracker! You're already a winner in our eyes, as all the money you raise will help Marie Curie spread care, comfort and joy this Christmas.

Work out when and where

Choose to host your quiz at home, down the pub – or you could opt for one online. If you're booking a venue, make sure to do it in advance.

Spread some cheer

Invite your friends, family, neighbours or colleagues to come along and see if they'll be crowned a Snow-It-All!! If relevant ask the venue manager to share details with suppliers too. The more the merrier when it comes to festive fun and the fundraising.

Charge an entry fee

You could set a fee per person, or per team if your quiz is a bigger event. We suggest £5 to £10 as a guide, but the amount is up to you. Set up a [Just Giving](#) page to collect donations, or ask for cash on the day if that's easier. Just make sure you keep it somewhere secure and out of sight if hosting your quiz in a public place.

Don't forget a prize

It's the season of goodwill – so why not offer a prize to the winning person or team? You can keep it festive by making it a classic Christmas treat or a bottle of fizz. Mention the prize on the invitation – it might just help pull in the guests.

Sleigh your fundraising

Boost donations by hosting some Christmassy games between quiz rounds. You could organise a round of bingo using our template, play pin-the-nose-on-Rudolph or host a Christmas jumper competition!

Let's get quizzical!

We've made things easy by creating question and answer sheets for you. You can always add your own to make sure it works for your guests.

You'll need to appoint a quiz master or take on the role yourself. Don't forget to have a tiebreak question ready, with the closest guess winning [e.g. How many mince pies do people eat in the UK every year?

Answer: 800 million] Finally, remind guests it's a no-phone zone – or they'll be on the naughty list!

On the night

Make your quiz be merry and bright with some finishing touches:

Offer a prize for the best Christmas-themed team name.

Invite teams to nominate their joker card round in advance for double points.

Throw in a tasting round – it could be Christmas chocolate tubs or festive cheese and crackers. Remember to check for allergies in advance.

Quiz hack

Get teams or contestants to mark each other's answer sheets at the end of each round. It makes it easier for you and it gets people chatting.
