This document highlights all the information you require to get to one of our official Marie Curie cheer stations at this year's London Marathon. Please note, London on Race Day is always extremely busy, so please take time moving from area to area and take into consideration it might take you a little bit longer moving around London than usual.

This year, we have an incredible team of volunteers and staff across our six cheer stations around London, who will be on site from 8am to set up.

Getting to our cheer stations & post-race reception

Please plan your journey carefully by checking TFL for planned disruptions www.tfl.gov.uk. Road closures will be in place and barriers are placed along the route. This might mean that roads are difficult to cross.

Below are the location details of our six cheer stations as well as the names of our cheer station managers. If you're planning on attending one or multiple of our cheer stations, please come and ask for the cheer station manager. They will ensure you're put onto the barrier and looked after throughout your time with us. The daffodil shows where we plan to be at each area.

1. Mile 5 Motivation Station

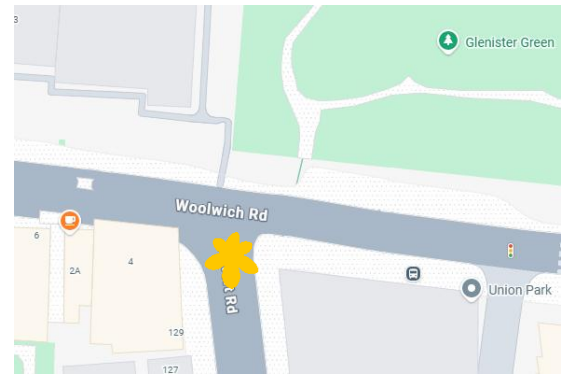
Left-hand side of the road

2. Mile 10 Melodies

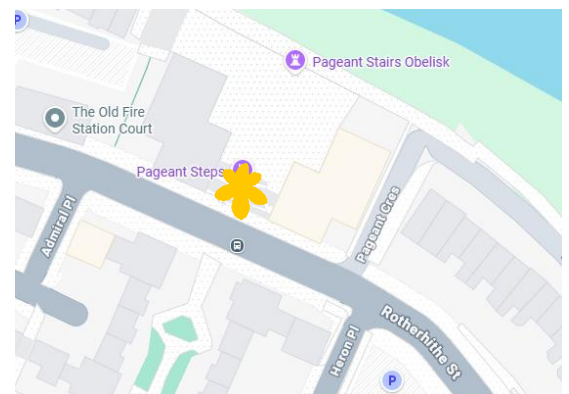
Right-hand side of the road

3. Mile 15 Remembrance Runway

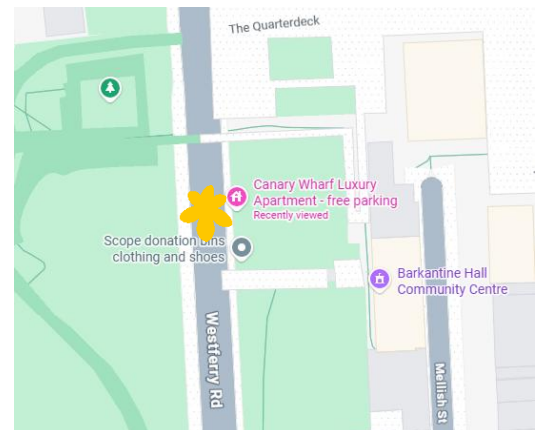
Both sides of the road

4. Mile 21 Rainbow Row

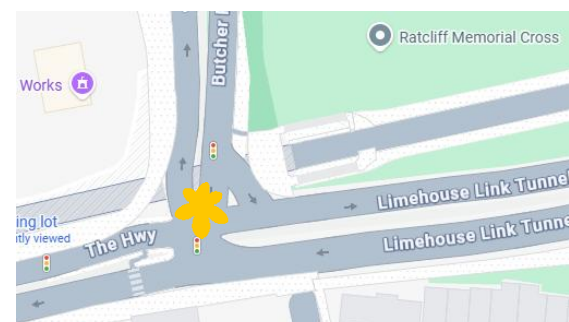
Left-hand side of the road

5. Mile 22 Looks Good on You

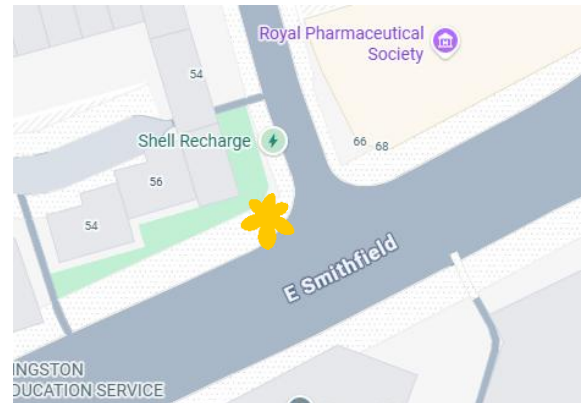
Right-hand side of the road

6. Mile 24.5 The Final Push

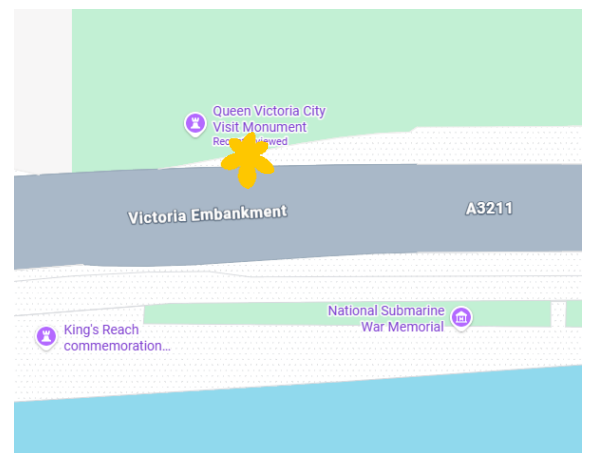
Right-hand side of the road

The daffodil marks the entrance to come through to the venue

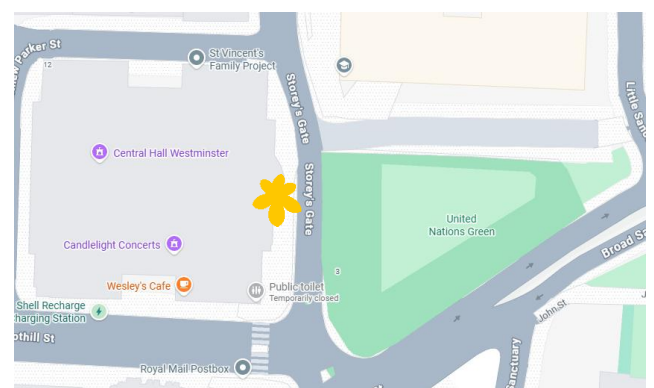
Reception Manager: Eilidh

Please note, we will have Marie Curie volunteers within the Meet & Greet area, at Horse Guards Parade. Our volunteers will be there to meet runners and take them to the post-race reception.
